

NOTICE – Rhode Island Insurance

Effective November 1, 2009, the Rhode Island Department of Business Regulation/Insurance Division will no longer issue separate licenses for Commercial Adjusters and Personal Adjusters. These will be combined into one license for Property/Casualty Adjusters. There will continue to be a separate license for Worker's Compensation Adjusters.

The examinations for Commercial Adjusters and Personal Adjusters are very similar and will be combined to form one Property/Casualty Adjuster examination. Reservations for the updated Property/Casualty Adjuster examination will be available in the June/July timeframe. The updated Property/Casualty Adjuster exam will be administered beginning November 1, 2009.
