

WHAT TO BRING — 2011 EQUIPMENT LIST COLORADO BARBER AND COSMETOLOGY

GENERAL BAG

(THESE ITEMS SHOULD BE IN A LARGE CONTAINER OR SEPARATE CONTAINER AND LABELED: "DISINFECTED")

- Sanitizer (Labeled: Sanitizer)
- Hand sanitizer (Labeled: Hand Sanitizer)
- Paper towels
- Trash bag or trash can (Labeled: Trash)
- Spray bottle with water (Labeled: Water)
- First Aid kit containing: adhesive bandages, gauze or cotton wipe, antiseptic (Labeled: Antiseptic), gloves, and 2 small baggies (Labeled: Biohazard bags)
- Large separate container labeled: "Soiled" (All items that are reusable go into this container after skill set)
- Clips
- Facial mannequins will be provided at each test site

OTHER ITEMS TO BRING

- Plain colored smock (Highly recommended, but not mandatory)
- Barbers and Hairstylists must bring 2 mannequins. (Presectioned/pre-parted mannequins are prohibited, and candidate will be disqualified)
- Mannequin stand and/or extender
- Small whisk broom and dustpan (Optional) (On carpeted floors, a comb works best to clean up cut hair)

Please Note: Biohazard containers are at each test site for blade disposal and blood spill baggies.

THERMAL STYLING

CURLING IRON

- Cotton towel for draping
- White paper or white towel
- Curling iron
- Heat resistant combs
- Clippies (Optional)
- Styling aids (Optional and labeled correctly)

THERMAL STYLING

FLAT IRON OR PRESSING COMB

- Cotton towel for draping
- White paper or white towel
- Heat resistant comb
- Flat iron or pressing comb

CHEMICAL RELAXER

RETOUCH OR VIRGIN

- Towels
- Chemical cape
- Non metal comb or applicator brush
- Base cream (Labeled: Base cream)
- Disposable gloves
- Relaxer (Labeled: Relaxer)

HAIR REMOVAL — EYEBROW TWEEZING

(SINGULAR BROW)

- Antiseptic (Labeled: Antiseptic)
- Disposable gloves
- Tweezers
- Gauze, cotton, or cotton rounds

BASIC FACIAL

- Head drape (Both headband and cap)
- Cotton towel or drape for chest
- Cleanser (Labeled: Cleanser)
- Cotton, gauze or esthetic wipes
- Massage cream (Labeled: Massage cream)
- Spatulas, or squeeze or pump bottles
- Toner (Labeled: Toner) or Astringent (Labeled: Astringent)
- Moisturizer (Labeled: Moisturizer)

FACIAL

SKIN CLEANSING

- Head drape (Both headband and cap)
- Cotton towel or drape for chest
- Cleanser (Labeled: Cleanser)
- Cotton, gauze or esthetic wipes
- Spatulas or squeeze or pump bottles

MALE FACIAL

- Head drape (Both headband and cap)
- Cleanser (Labeled: Cleanser)
- 2–3 Mock steam towels
- Massage cream (Labeled: Massage cream)
- Toner (Labeled: Toner) or Astringent (Labeled: Astringent)
- Moisturizer (Labeled: Moisturizer)
- Spatulas, or squeeze or pump bottles
- Extra towel for chest drape

HAIRCOLOR

HIGHLIGHTING

- 3–4 towels
- Chemical cape
- Disposable gloves
- Weaving comb or comb
- Foils
- Comb
- Applicator brush & bowl
- HairColor (Labeled: Haircolor)

HAIRCOLOR

RETOUCH OR VIRGIN

- 3–4 towels
- Chemical cape
- Disposable gloves
- Applicator bottle or bowl and applicator brush
- Haircolor (Labeled: Haircolor)
- Weaving comb or comb

TAPERED HAIRCUT

CLIPPERS

- Neckstrip
- Styling cape
- Combs
- Clippers
- Clean up items for removing cut hair
- Clippies or Duck bill clips

TAPERED HAIRCUT

SCISSORS OVER COMB

- Neckstrip
- Styling cape
- Scissors
- Combs
- Clean-up items for removing cut hair
- Clippies or Duck bill clips

BASIC LAYERED HAIRCUT

RAZOR

- Neckstrip
- Styling cape
- Spray water bottle (Labeled: Water)
- Combs
- Razor
- Clean-up items for removing cut hair
- Clippies or Duck bill clips

BASIC LAYERED HAIRCUT

SHEARS

- Neckstrip
- Styling cape
- Spray water bottle (Optional) (Labeled: Water)
- Combs
- Shears/Scissors
- Clean-up items for removing cut hair
- Clippies or Duck bill clips

BRAID

- Towel for draping
- Combs
- Brush (Optional)
- Rubber band

PERMANENT WAVE

- 2–3 Towels
- Chemical drape
- 3–5 Permanent rods
- End papers
- Combs
- Protective cream (Labeled: Protective cream) or Cotton
- Disposable gloves
- Perm bottle with water inside (Labeled: Perm wave solution)

HAIR REMOVAL

EYEBROW, UPPERLIP OR CHIN

- Antiseptic (Labeled: Antiseptic)
- Cotton rounds or gauze
- Disposable gloves
- Spatulas
- Strips
- Wax (mock) (Labeled: Wax)

NOTE: All Nail Services will require 5–7 Freddy Fingers: a separate finger for each service. Please glue tip on prior to examination to represent natural nail plate.

BASIC MANICURE

- Hand sanitizer (Labeled: Hand sanitizer)
- Manicure bowl
- Water (Labeled: Water)
- Emery boards and nail files
- Cuticle remover (Labeled: Cuticle remover)
- Spatulas
- Cotton-tipped orangewood sticks or cuticle pusher
- Manicure brush
- Cuticle nippers
- Towel

POLISH APPLICATION

- Polish correction pen.
- **DO NOT BRING REAL POLISH REMOVER**
- MOCK Polish remover (Labeled: Polish remover)
- Base coat (Labeled: Base coat)
- Dark polish (Labeled: Nail polish)
- Top coat (Labeled: Top coat)
- Cotton or wipes (Optional)

NAIL ENHANCEMENTS

NAIL TIP APPLICATION

- Hand sanitizer (Labeled: Hand sanitizer)
- Cotton-tipped orangewood sticks or cuticle pushers
- Cuticle Nippers
- Nail tips
- Files or emery boards
- Manicure brush
- Buffers
- Nail prep solution (Labeled: Nail prep)
- Nail glue (Labeled: Nail glue)

ACRYLIC

OVER FORM OR ON NATURAL NAIL

OR OVERLAY WITH TIP

- Hand Sanitizer (Labeled: Hand sanitizer)
- Cuticle pusher or cotton-tipped orangewood sticks
- Cuticle Nippers
- Nail tips
- Files or emery boards
- Buffers
- Manicure brush
- Nail forms
- Nail prep solution (Labeled: Nail prep)
- Primer (Labeled: Primer)
- Odorless acrylic (If acrylic is not odorless, the candidate will be disqualified on this skill)
- Odorless monomer (If monomer is not odorless, the candidate will be disqualified on this skill)
- Nail glue (Labeled: Nail glue)
- Acrylic nail brush
- Cuticle oil (Labeled: Cuticle oil)

FACIAL MANIPULATIONS

INCLUDES FACE, NECK, AND SHOULDERS

- Head drape (Includes cap and headband)
- Client drape or towel
- Massage cream (Labeled: Massage cream)
- Spatulas
- Cotton rounds, gauze, or cotton
- Toner (Labeled: Toner) or Astringent (Labeled: Astringent)
- Moisturizer (Labeled: Moisturizer)

MASQUE APPLICATION

- Head drape (Includes cap and headband)
- Client drape or towel
- Pre moistened eye pads in a baggie (Labeled: Eye pads)
- Masque (Labeled: Masque)
- Applicator brush
- Spatulas or squeeze/pump bottles
- Toner (Labeled: Toner) or astringent (Labeled: Astringent)
- Moisturizer (Labeled: Moisturizer)
- Gauze or cotton rounds

MAKEUP APPLICATION

- Powder concealer/highlighter (Labeled: Concealer/highlighter)
- Powder foundation (Labeled: Foundation)
- Powder eye shadow (Labeled: Eye shadow)
- Eyebrow pencil (Labeled: Eyebrow pencil)
- Pencil sharpener
- Mascara (Labeled: Mascara)
- Powder blush (Labeled: blush)
- Lipcolor (Labeled: Lipcolor)
- Disposable applicators

Note: Please be aware that the candidate must remove makeup after application and will need to bring something to clean mannequin. Mr. Clean magic erasers work the best. This part is not included in the timeframe.

Note: If you use a large beauty school Makeup Compact, all of the cosmetics must be labeled on the outside of that compact.

SHAVING FACE AND NECK

- Haircutting cape
- 4–5 Terry towels
- Shaving cream
- Razor without blade
- Astringent (Labeled: Astringent) or Toner (Labeled: Toner)

SKIN ANALYSIS

- Inexpensive magnifying glass
